With generous support from the Tang Research Foundation, the T'ang Studies Society is pleased to announce funding for grants to support research in any discipline on the Tang dynasty in a broad geographical and chronological scope. The grant can support various types of expenses that arise during research including travel, book purchases, graduate assistants, and databases fees.

General Requirements:

- This grant is intended to support research by scholars who hold the Ph.D. and are at any career stage.
- Applicants must be members of the Society in good standing at the time of application. Information on membership can be found at www.tangstudies.org/Membership.
- Research may involve the Sui, Tang, and Five Dynasties period (589—959 C.E.), and Tang in a global context, tracing cultural and political connections to Korea, Japan, Central Asia, and beyond.
- Applicants may only apply for one type of Society grant during a given year.

Grant Information:

Amount of Award: Up to \$3000

Application Deadline: **August 30, 2020**. Recipients will be notified by **September 30, 2020**.

Application Process:

Applicants must submit:

- a two-page proposal describing the project and the specific component that this grant would support;
- a C.V.;
- a budget that itemizes anticipated expenses;
- a statement describing what support, if any, the applicant expects to receive from other sources (including from his or her institution).
